Thy Kingdom Come 2021



Thy Kingdom Come is a global prayer movement which runs for the 11 days between the Christian festivals of Ascension and Pentecost, i.e. Thursday 13th May to Sunday 23rd.

People are invited to pray in whatever way they want and with whoever they want for others to come to know Jesus Christ. One way in which GSFC is usually involved is 'Pray for Five'. Choose five people you would regularly like to pray for and write their names down on a list. If you're not sure who to pray for, ask God to guide you as you choose. Once you have settled on 5 names, commit to praying for them regularly. There are lots of ways you can remind yourself to do this:

- Set a reminder to ping on your phone
- Stick a post it note by your kettle or on the bathroom mirror
- Tie five knots in a piece of string and tie it round your wrist or keep it in your pocket

If you are still going for your 'daily walk' use that time to pray for the neighbours on your street or local shopkeepers.

If you do the school run, choose 5 parents at the school gate and pray for them.

If you find your prayers getting 'samey', you might like to use the acrostic 'BLESS' and pray for a different aspect of your person's life each day:

Body

Leisure

Emotions

Social

Spirit
